(East Claydon Road, Winslow)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER, 2018

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order, which will temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding, except for access, in that length of East Claydon Road, Winslow, which commences from Granborough Road to its junction with Church Way.

The alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be via Granborough Road, Burleys Road, Verney Road, Furze Lane, Buckingham Road, Winslow Road, Lower Way, Main Street, Steeple Claydon Road, Herds Hill, Claydon Hill, Sandhill Road and vice versa.

The closure is required whilst Transport for Buckinghamshire works take place and it is anticipated that the works will commence on 5 March 2018 and will take approximately 25 days to complete.

The Order will come into operation on 5 March 2018 when the appropriate signs are lawfully displayed and will continue for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

Penalties for not observing these restrictions will be as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
